- 1.5 1st Open Blitz
- 1.6 2<sup>nd</sup> Open Blitz
- **1.7** Boys under 10 (Date of birth 2007 and after)
- **1.8** Girls under 10 (Date of birth 2007 and after)
- 1.9 Boys under 8 (Date of birth 2009 and after)
- 1.10 Girls under 8 (Date of birth 2009 and after)

#### 2. System and Rate of Play

- 2.1 Time Control:
  - **Open A** Playing time: 90 minutes for 40 moves plus 30 minutes for the rest of the game with an increment of 30 seconds per move, starting from move one.
  - Open B, Open C, Open D, U10, U8 B&G 90 minutes plus 30 seconds per move.
- **2.2** Festival tournaments system: 9 rounds played in the Swiss system.
- **2.3** Pairings will be carried out with the computer program **SwissManager.**
